



SCHOOL OF DANCE

SAFETY GUIDELINES

Please see our new safety guidelines for reopening the dance school below. We have done extensive research to find the best products, systems, and practices to put in place so we can all feel safe returning to the dance school.

AIR PURIFIERS

We have invested in a Medify Air Purifier to improve the air quality within each dance room. This system uses the highest quality/medical grade, True HEPA H13 filters. All dance rooms, as well as the hallway and office, will have their own individual unit. Each unit was specifically selected to accommodate the square footage for each area.

STUDIO SANITIZATION

We will be using **SmartTouch** to disinfect and clean the Dance School. This is hospital grade disinfectant. * EPA registered, hospital grade disinfectant * NSF registered D2 sanitizer on food contact surfaces * Kills 99.999% of bacteria including E. Coli & Salmonella in less than 60 seconds.

BIOPROTECT Hand Sanitizer will be provided for all teachers and dancers. *Provides up to 6 hours of extended hand protection *Effective against 99.99% of germs and bacteria *Alcohol free, fragrance free, paraben & sulfate free formula *Aloe Vera infused

We will be disinfecting surfaces and common areas between groups of students/classes.

SCHEDULING CLASSES

Time will be scheduled between classes for disinfecting surfaces and bathrooms, as well as, limiting student interactions. Please see below for more specific details.

BEFORE ARRIVAL

- Minimize belongings – all items need to fit in a secure bag which will stay with the dancer
- Dancers must come dressed and prepared for class
- Hair must be fully pulled back and secured (new hair ties will no longer be handed out)

DROP OFF & PICK UP

- Dancers must wait in their vehicles, or outside, until the teacher opens the door for entry
- No early drop offs
- When students arrive, they will be asked to use the hand sanitizer provided at the studio entrance
- When students are dismissed from class, immediate exit/pick-up will be required to allow time for cleaning
- New entry/exit locations will be given once enrolled (second entrance will be created to help minimize student contact)

STUDIO GUIDELINES

- All waiting areas will be closed – all seating areas will be removed
- No food/drink (except for water bottles) – we encourage dancers to bring a water bottle as water fountains will no longer be accessible
- No partner work – including hand holding and lifts

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

- Teachers will be self-monitoring their own symptoms and health
- If your dancer is experiencing any cold or flu symptoms, please keep them at home.
- Due to the activity level, teachers and dancers will not be wearing masks.
